Notice to All Vendors:

The Texas Comptroller's office will be requesting a list of our vendors immediately following the festival to follow up on <u>sales taxes due</u>. Most items sold in Texas are taxable, and the Chamber encourages you to familiarize yourself with the requirements if you do not already hold a Sales Tax and Use Permit. The only exempt items that we commonly see sold at festivals are grocery items not meant to be consumed on site (bottled salsas, jellies, etc.), and information-only booths. If you have not yet supplied us with your Sales and Use Tax Permit number, we will require a letter from you stating that your items are exempt, along with a copy of your driver's license, before we can allow you to set up.

Important Notice to All Food Vendors:

The Texas Department of Health Services may be at our Festival checking for Retail Food Establishment permits and, unfortunately, will immediately shut down vendors who do not have a copy of the permit with them. Also please be aware that food may not be prepared in a home kitchen and then brought to the festival for serving, but must be prepared in a commercial type kitchen at a church or school, or prepared completely on-site at the festival itself. Temporary permits are \$52 and should be requested as soon as possible so that they have time to process your application. Please ensure that you have your Retail Permit with you on the day of the festival. No refunds for lack of permit.

The only exemptions are for foods that fall under "Cottage Food" - foods that do not need to be kept hot or cold, such as breads, cookies, jellies, and nuts.

2024 Sassafras Festival Rules and Regulations for Food Vendors

Date: The Sassafras Festival Celebration will be held Saturday, October 26, 2024.

Booth Description: Booths are 10' X 10' on a paved surface. Exhibitors must furnish their own food service supplies, tables, chairs, signs, etc. Bring your own extension cords if you purchase electricity. No generators allowed.

Booth Set Up: Booth can be set up on Friday, October 25th from 4:00 - 7:00 pm or Saturday, October 26 between 6:00 am and 8:30 am and must be fully set up and ready to operate by 10:00 a.m. All vehicles must be removed from the square by 8:45 am. Canopies are allowed but must not exceed 10 x 10 boundaries and must be sturdy. Trailer hitches CANNOT extend beyond purchased space. Festival officials reserve the right to request removal of any structure deemed unsafe, or for any other reason.

Booth Tear Down: Booth must remain set up until 5:00 pm Saturday. Early tear down must be authorized by Chamber Officials.

Restrictions: Management reserves the right to ban the sale or display of any product not previously approved. All vendor merchandise is subject to approval. No weapons (except on Chamber approval for raffle displays), silly string, fireworks or pornographic material will be allowed. Violators will be subject to immediate removal from the grounds.

Clean-Up: Each Sassafras Festival Celebration participant is responsible for his/her own trash clean up at the conclusion of the festival. Please do not leave anything behind. Violators may be fined or refused space in the future.

Security: Limited security will be provided from the opening of the festival until closing Saturday evening; however, neither the festival nor any other entity assumes liability for any losses.

You MUST provide your Texas Sales and Use Tax Permit number to us, collect appropriate sales taxes, and remit them to the Texas Comptroller in compliance with state law. A current Retail Food Establishment Permit MUST be presented at check-in or at any time requested by festival officials or health inspector, unless the organization is an exempt 510(c)3 or Cottage Food producer.
